It's well done and has a lot of historical footage of the people involved (and cool 1980's hairstyles!)

You can stream it for free from [pbs.org](https://www.pbs.org) if you have a "passport" account.

You can stream it for free from Amazon Prime if you subscribe to their PBS documentaries channel.

You can stream it for 4.99 from Amazon Prime if you don't have the PBS documentaries subscription.

It is NOT available for streaming through the HoCo library streaming services (Kanopy or Hoopla)
